ALBANY Peter J. DiLillo, 75, of Orchard Avenue died Friday, October 6 at the Albany Medical Center Hospital. He was a lifelong resident of Albany, and had attended Morrisville State College and Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute.

Mr. DiLillo was an Army veteran of World War II. He was employed as a civil engineer at the state Department of Transportation in Albany for more than 30 years, and later worked for the city of Albany as deputy city engineer.

Mr. DiLillo also worked for the Boys Club of America for more than 20 years, and for a time served as director of the Albany Boys Club.

He was a communicant of Holy Cross Church.
